
Car accidents in Las Vegas are big news. In the past 12 months, the Las Vegas Sun has published 120 articles about serious crashes<sup>†</sup> - usually including a fatality. And that doesn't include accidents causing non-fatal injuries and property damage that don't make the news. Fatal crashes in Nevada are on the rise<sup>†</sup>, and many of those occur in Clark County, home to Las Vegas and nearly two-thirds of the state's population. Here are some facts and figures about traffic accidents that shed some light on driving in Sin City and around the state.



According to the Nevada Department of Public Safety's Office of Traffic Safety, in 2021 there were 357 deadly crashes across the state that resulted in 382 deaths - a 19% increase in deadly crashes and a 17.9% increase in deaths from the previous year.



Clark County accounted for 224 fatal crashes in 2021, up 24% from 2020. Fatalities increased almost 22%.
